

Royal Navy ship HMS Montrose in Sri Lanka

Commanding Officer of the Royal Navy ship HMS Montrose Commander Conor O'Neill explained that the ship's visit was part of their global deployment and that Sri Lanka was an important partner of the United Kingdom.

The Type 23 frigate arrived at the Colombo harbour on her way to Bahrain via a couple of brief stops in the Asian region.

region.
"We left the UK last October and are en route to our final location in Bahrain where the ship would be deployed for next few years," he said.

The Commanding Officer said a longstanding friendship exists between the Sri Lankan Navy and the Royal Navy. "We will continue to further strengthen these relationships during this visit," he said.

"This visit is a logistic stop for us. Montrose engages in global deployment. We have been supporting the UK's interest and allies across the Pacific, Asia Pacific region to the China seas," the commander said.

He said the Royal Navy will hold bilateral meeting and exercises with the Sri Lankan Navy during the visit.

Meanwhile, Deputy British High Commissioner Tom Burn said that the visit of Royal Navy HMS Montrose is an opportunity to deepen the relationship between the UK and Sri Lanka. "We delighted to have the HMS Montrose in Colombo. We think that there is plenty of scope working together and for learning from each other on how to tackle social challenges that many countries face around the region", he said.

HMS Montrose, which has a crew of 200 including 20 officers, is the eleventh of the thirteen ship Type 23 or Duke class of frigates of the Royal Navy.

Once in the Middle East, the ship will stay there for up to three years conducting security patrols, with the crew being replaced every four months to sustain her long-term security and peacekeeping presence.

Largest oil field production asset calls Sri Lanka

Hayleys Energy Services (HES), yesterday ushered in the first floating production storage and offloading (FPSO) asset to ever call Sri Lanka, in collaboration with the Hambantota International Port Group (HIPG).

The FPSO asset, Dhirubhai-1, is expected to be docked at the Hambantota International Port for a minimum of six months for a warm lay-up.

The owners of Dhirubhai-1, Aker Contracting FP ASA together with its technical manager Aker Floating Production based out of Norway, focuses on the business of owning, chartering and operating Floating, Production, Storage and Offloading (FPSO) vessels equipped for offshore Oil and Gas production.

The arrival of Dhirubhai-1, marks the second vessel to call on the Port of Hambantota for lay-up services, the first being the arrival of the Oil & Gas Drillship "Aban Abraham" in December 2018 initiated by Hayleys Energy Services.

"Sri Lanka has many remarkable facets to offer the world and we are pleased to see the potential of Sri Lanka, being showcased through projects of this nature. To page iv

One of the largest and most valuable assets in the Oil & Gas industry being brought in for lay-up services to the Hambantota Port sends a clear message to the world about the quality of the services that we as Sri Lankans can offer," said Ruwan Waidyaratne, Managing Director – Hayleys Advantis Limited. He said, "The Hambantota International Port Group was a key factor in attracting this FPSO asset to Sri Lanka, by offering a long-term quayside berth. This enabled Hayleys Energy Services to attract Aker to Sri Lanka, moving this project away(\$\sigma\$) (from traditional lay-up locations in the region."

Dhirubhai-I comes out of a 10 year project, where it was operating at a depth of 1200m off the East Coast of India. Given the proximity advantage of bringing this vessel for lay-up services at the Hambantota International Port, HES took initiative in persuading the owners, Aker Floating Production. In light of the continuing lay-up service projects coming into the Port of Hambantota, Hayleys Energy Services has even set up a permanent office within the Port, on the 6th Floor of the Sayuru-paya Building, Hambantota International Port, the first by an Oil & Gas Services company at this port.

Commenting on the arrival of the FPSO asset, Ray

Ren, Chief Executive Officer - Hambantota International Port Group said, "This is a great endorsement for the Hambantota International Port. We appreciate the efforts of our partner Hayleys Energy Services, in joining us to market Hambantota International Port as a multipurpose port which is now moving from Ro-Ro operations to multiple other services, with a clear vision of becoming the energy hub of the region. The 6 month warm layup of Dhirubhai-1 showcases the port's potential and the expertise of our team. We look forward to continuing to work with Hayleys Energy Services in the future."

Meanwhile, Chas Charles, Director/Chief Executive Officer (CEO) - Hayleys Energy Services said, "This bodes well for the Government plans of calling for a licensing round for exploration and development work of the remaining blocks of the Mannar and Cauvery basins planned for next year. Setting up an Oil & Gas service hub, with experienced personnel well ahead of the first licensing round, will help build the relevant technical expertise to service the global Oil & Gas companies, making Sri Lanka an even more attractive location for them."

"I am glad to announce that the SLPA, upon Cabinet approval, is now in the process of purchasing three STS cranes for the JCT 5 expansion. The US\$ 25 million investment has

been approved by a Cabinet-

appointed procurement committee," Minister Ratnayaka tweeted yesterday.

"This is the first step in a rapid, accelerated expansion programme to cater to the growing demand from our customers. We will continue to listen and improve as required by market conditions," the Minister added.

The government last year decided to expand JCT 5 with a wider quay and modern equipment, with a US\$ 70 million investment.

"This will allow two 360 metre vessels to berth at the Colombo Port at the same time. The Cabinet approval for the purchase was given last week. The SLPA will buy the cranes from a Chinese supplier, selected according to the Cabinet-approved procurement process," the Minister stressed.



HIP will also be looking at a number of associated services such as FW supply, sludge removals etc., which are already in the pipeline."

Hayleys Energy Services, Hambantota International Port Group in largest oil field production asset to come to Sri Lanka

Hayleys Energy Services (HES), the pioneer in Oil and Gas support services in Sri Lanka, last week ushered in the first floating production storage and offloading (FPSO) asset to ever call Sri Lanka, in collaboration with the Hambantota International Port Group (HIPG). The FPSO asset – Dhirubhai-1, is expected to be docked at the Hambantota International Port for a minimum of six months for a warm lay-up.

The owners of Dhirubhai-1, Aker Contracting FP ASA together with its technical manager Aker Floating Production based out of Norway focuses on the business of owning chartering and operating Floating, Production, Storage and Offloading (FPSO) vessels equipped for offshore Oil and Gas production.

The arrival of Dhirubhai-1, marks the second vessel to call on the Port of Hambantota for lay-up services, the first being the arrival of the Oil and Gas Drillship "Aban Abraham" in December 2018 initiated by HES, the company said in a media release.

"Sri Lanka has many remarkable facets to offer the world and we are pleased to see the potential of Sri Lanka, being showcased through pro-jects of this nature. One of the largest and most valuable assets in the Oil and Gas industry being brought in for lay-up services to the Hambantota Port sends a clear message to the world about the quality of the services that we as Sri Lankans can offer, said Ruwan Waidyaratne, Managing Director - Hayleys Advantis Ltd. He added: "The Hambantota Hambantota International Port Group was a key factor in attracting this FPSO asset to Sri Lanka, by offering a long-term quayside berth. This enabled Hayleys Energy Services to attract Aker to Sri Lanka, moving this project away from traditional lay-up locations in the

Dhirubhai-1 comes out of a 10 year project, where it was operating at a depth of 1200m off the East Coast of India. Given the proximity advantage of bringing this vessel for lay-up services at the Hambantota International Port, HES took the initiative in persuading the owners, Aker Floating Production. In light of the continuing lay-up service projects coming into the Port of Hambantota, HES has even set up a permanent office within the Port, on the 6th Floor of the Sayurupaya Building, Hambantota International Port, the first by an Oil and Gas Services company at this port.

Commenting on the arrival of the FPSO asset, Ray Ren, Chief Executive Officer - Hambantota International Port Group said: "This is a great endorsement for the Hambantota International Port. We appreciate the efforts of our partner Hayleys Energy Services, in joining us to market Hambantota International Port as a

multipurpose port which is now moving from Ro-Ro operations to multiple other services, with a clear vision of becoming the energy hub of the region. The 6 month warm layup of Dhirubhai-1 showcases the port's potential and the expertise of our team. We look forward to continuing to work with Hayleys Energy Services in the future."

Meanwhile, Chas Charles, Director/
Chief Executive Officer (CEO) - HES
said, "This bodes well for the
Government plans of calling for a
licensing round for exploration and
development work of the remaining
blocks of the Mannar and Cauvery
basins planned for next year. Setting up
an Oil and Gas service hub, with experienced personnel well ahead of the
first licensing round, will help build
the relevant technical expertise to service the global Oil and Gas companies,
making Sri Lanka an even more attractive location for them."
